July 20, 2015

A workshop with the Town Board of the Town of Greenville and the Greenville Rescue Squad was held on Monday, July 20, 2015 at 5:30 pm at Pioneer Hall. Four board members were present; Councilman Stern was absent. There were 7 members of the Greenville Rescue Squad present (K. Aspenleiter, A. Scirico, F. Sickles, B. Toomey, R. Lang, T. Nugent, and C. Powell III), as well as 4 guests. Supervisor Macko opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Supervisor Macko presented available options to consider for providing EMS service to the Town. These include contracting with the Greenville Rescue Squad, the Durham Rescue Squad, or using the proposed County-wide system. Discussion ensued. Mr. Macko wants to offer the best service at the most reasonable cost. It was suggested the Town Boards of Durham and Greenville meet to discuss how a combined service could meet the needs of the residents in both towns. Supervisor Macko will follow up with Durham Town Supervisor Bill Carr.

This workshop was adjourned at 6:30 pm.

The regular monthly meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Greenville followed at 7:00 pm. Four board members continued in attendance; Attorney Tal Rappleyea and 12 guests were present as well. Supervisor Macko repeated the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mr. Davis moved to accept the Clerk's minutes of June 15, 2015, seconded by Mr. Bensen. Carried 4 ayes

Oral and written reports were received from the Highway, Buildings and Grounds, Code, Planning and Zoning Boards, Sewer and Water departments. Additionally, concerns were brought to the Board's attention regarding discrepancies between the Town's fees at the Recycling Center and what Greene County charges. Appliances with Freon (Refrigerators, Freezers, Air Conditioners) are collected with a \$7.50 fee at the County site, and \$15.00 in Greenville.

Mr. Davis moved, seconded by Mr. Bear, to amend the fee schedule at our Recycling Center to be consistent with Greene County, and charge \$7.50 for appliances with Freon.

New business discussed at 8:00 pm:

The ZBA recommended changes be made in their fee schedule as well, to allow for multiple variances on one building site to be charged only one variance fee per project.

Mr. Bensen moved, seconded by Mr. Bear, to allow this change as outlined above.

A proposal to replace and update lighting on Town property was received by Lime Energy Company, in coordination with available grant money.

Mr. Davis moved, seconded by Mr. Bensen, to update the exterior lighting at the Town Library at a final cost of \$2,304.65.

Mr. Bensen moved, seconded by Mr. Davis, to set a public hearing on the proposed 2015 Zoning Law on Monday, August 31st, 2015 at 6:30 pm in Pioneer Town Hall.

Mr. Bear moved to enter executive session at 8:30 pm to discuss collective bargaining negotiations per Article 14 of Civil Service Law, and proposed, pending or current litigation. Seconded by Mr. Davis.

Mr. Davis moved to return to regular session at 8:47 pm, seconded by Mr. Bensen. Carried 4 ayes
