Per NYS law, the owner of any dog reaching the age of four months must apply for a dog license. The license is to be obtained in the town in which the dog is harbored, or lives. All licenses are valid for one year with an option for a two year licensing period, if certain circumstances are met. (The rabies vaccine must remain valid throughout the entire two year license, and the fee must be paid for two years as well). Regarding the rabies vaccine, it is first given as a 1-year dose, and each subsequent dose is good for a 3-year period. Your vet will provide you with proof of vaccination. A license renewal notice will be sent to the dog owner each year, 5 weeks prior to the license's expiration date. The fee for an altered dog is \$10.00 per year; an unaltered dog is \$20.00 per year. Savings for dog owners aged 65 and older result in discounts of \$3.00 per year, per dog (this should already be reflected on the renewal form... the fee decreases to either \$7 or \$17 per dog, depending on neuter/spay status). Fees are payable by cash, check, or money order. A late fee of \$25 will apply if the renewal is not paid within 30 days of the expiration date.
