The organizational meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Greenville was held on January 3, 2022 at 7:00 pm. Four Board members were present, John Bensen was absent. There was representation from: Highway, Building and Grounds, Code, and Water departments as well as the Planning Board. Councilman Rauf motioned to open the meeting at 7:01 pm, with a second by Councilman Bear.

Councilman Richards made a motion, seconded by Councilman Rauf, to go into executive session to discuss medical, financial, credit or employment history of a particular person/corp., or matters leading to said dismissal, removal, promotion, appointment, employment, discipline, demotion, or suspension at 7:02 pm. Carried 4 ayes

Councilman Bear made a motion, seconded by Councilman Rauf, to return to Regular Session at 7:15 pm. No motions were made in Executive Session.

Organizational resolutions and the procurement policy were read by the Board.

After review, Councilman Rauf motioned to accept the organizational resolutions, seconded by Councilman Bear. Carried 4 ayes

Discussion points throughout the reading of the organizational resolutions:

- Councilman Richards emphasized that department heads need to be present for budget workshops/meetings/hearings, etc.
- Don Teator requested that the Town Board attend more Planning Board meetings, stating that the Planning Board is a stronger Board with their presence.
- Supervisor Macko went to Greenville Saw this week seeking an update on the tractor that was purchased for snow removal. No update was received as they are closed due to Covid-19.

There being no further business, Supervisor Macko moved to adjourn the meeting at 8:08 pm.
