**Meeting Minutes**: Councilman Bear motioned, seconded by Councilman VonAtzingen to approve the meeting minutes for the March 18, 2024 monthly meeting. Carried 5 ayes

#### **Old Business**

The following monthly department reports were given.

**Highway** – Blacktop bids were advertised in the Town's official newspaper, The Catskill Daily Mail, on April 5<sup>th</sup>&9<sup>th</sup>, 2024. The following bids were received:

Cobleskill Stone Products Inc. - \$269,700.00 (\$89.90/ton) \*no mention of milling, bid not to requested specs\*

A.Colarusso & Son, Inc. - \$268,500.00 (\$89.50/ton)

Callanan Industries, Inc. - \$241,500.00 (\$80.50/ton) \*no mention of milling, bid not to requested specs\*

Councilman Macko motioned, seconded by Councilman Bear to award the 2024 blacktop bid to A. Colarusso & Son, Inc for \$268,500.00 (\$89.50/ton). Carried 5 ayes
Highway Superintendent Mike Dudley read the attached report.

**Building & Grounds** – Maintenance Supervisor Trainee Joe Murphy gave a report of the month's activity of the maintenance department. No motions were made.

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**Code Enforcement** – Councilman Macko read the submitted report attached.

**Planning Board** – Planning Board Chair Don Teator read the attached report.

**Dog Control** – Supervisor Bensen read the attached memo stating that the DCO's site inspection was in passing condition by Ag & Market.

Beautification – Barbara Walter reported that the Summer Concert Series has been scheduled and CPOG is requesting the Town for a \$3,000 contribution towards the concerts. Councilman Macko motioned, seconded by Councilman Bear to pay \$3,000.00 to Community Partners of Greenville to use towards the Summer Concert Series. Carried 5 ayes

**District #4 County Legislator** – Greg Davis briefed the Board on the current projects at the County.

#### **New Business**

**Park Clean-up Day** – is May 4<sup>th</sup> from 9-12. All are welcome to come help clean up trash and work on the trails.

**AOT Finance School** – Councilman Bear motioned, seconded by Councilman Macko to pay for up to three attendees (maximum \$600) to attend AOT's annual finance school. Carried 5 ayes

**Grant Writers** – Councilman Bear motioned, seconded by Councilman VonAtzingen for to hire Sustainable Growth for \$1,200.00 to apply for the Greenway Grant. Carried 5 ayes

**Prevost Hall** – Ryan Biggs Clark Davis have sent the Town completed drawings of Phase I stabilization of Prevost Hall. *Councilman VonAtzingen motioned, seconded by Councilman Bear to advertise for bids on Phase 1 stabilization of Prevost Hall on April 20, 2024 and May 4, 2024 to be at 7pm at the May 20, 2024 Town Board meeting. <i>Carried 5 ayes* 

Water Management – Joe Myers of North Dome is meeting with General Controls to come up with a system and shopping list so they can take over management of the Town water system.

**NY Class Investments** – Tal said that NY Class Investment services does fit within the Town's procurement policy but it is recommended to get RBT's opinion on it.

**UTV for Park** – Councilman Bear motioned, seconded by Councilman VonAtzingen to purchase a brand new UTV from Salem Farm Supply for \$20,104.46 (Sourcewell NYS bid pricing). Carried 5 ayes CPOG meets this week and may be able to contribute funds towards this purchase.

**Bond** – Councilman Macko motioned, seconded by Councilman Bear to pay off the balances of the \$53k bond for the maintenance building and the \$65k bond for the Highway Dept Fuel system. Carried 5 ayes

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**Supervisor Report** – Councilman Macko motioned, seconded by Councilman Bear to approve the Supervisor's report. Carried 5 ayes
