A budget workshop was held by the Town Board of the Town of Greenville on October 21st, 2024 at 5:00 pm at Pioneer Hall.

The purpose of this meeting was to review the tentative budget with the adjustments made since the first budget workshop. The following discussions were had:

- Tax cap override to be adopted as a precaution. At this time the tax increase is 1.96% for the 2025 tentative budget.
- The Town does not have any indebtedness outside of the capitol projects at this time.
- There is a significant savings on workman’s comp costs for the town due to employee ages.

Councilman VonAtzingen motioned, seconded by Councilman Macko to accept the budget as presented to be the 2025 preliminary budget. Carried 4 ayes
