A public hearing was held by the Town Board of the Town of Greenville on October 21st, 2024 at 6:30 pm at Pioneer Hall regarding the adoption of a Local Law to Override the Tax Levy Limit established in General Municipal Law §3-c.

*At 6:46pm on October 16th, 2023 Councilman Macko motioned, seconded by Councilman Bear to open the Public Hearing for public remark on the adoption of a Local Law to Override the Tax Levy Limit.
Carried 4 ayes*

Supervisor Bensen read aloud the proposed law (see attached). Supervisor Bensen explained that this law is a safety net and that as of right now the preliminary budget for 2025 is under the 2% NYS requirement.

Supervisor Bensen called upon the hearing three times for any questions/comments/concerns.

Councilman Bensen motioned, seconded by Councilman Bear to close the public hearing.

Councilman Bear motioned, seconded by Councilman Bensen to adopt Local Law 3 of 2024 Tax Cap Override. Carried 4 ayes
